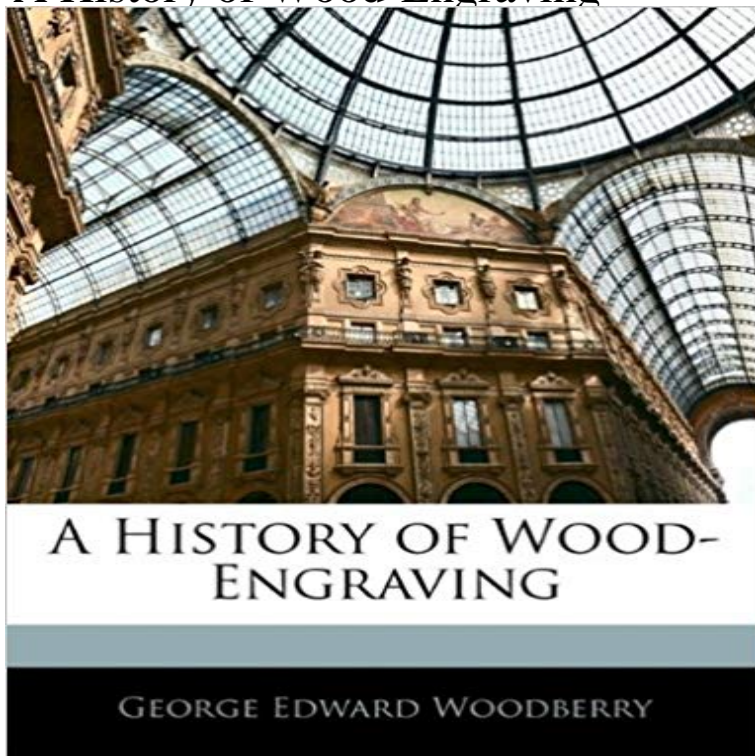


A History of Wood-Engraving
