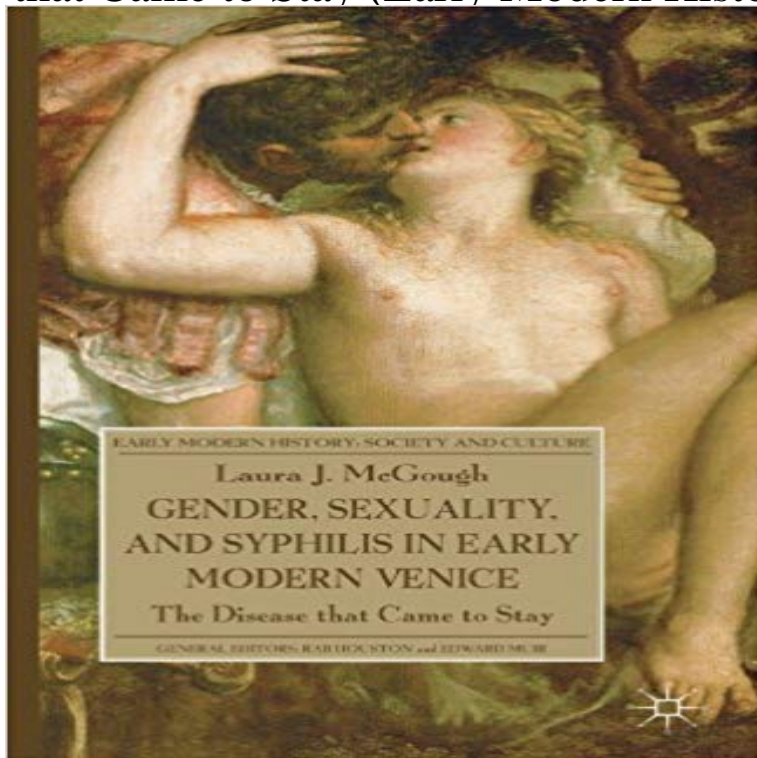


Gender, Sexuality, and Syphilis in Early Modern Venice: The Disease that Came to Stay (Early Modern History Society and Culture)
