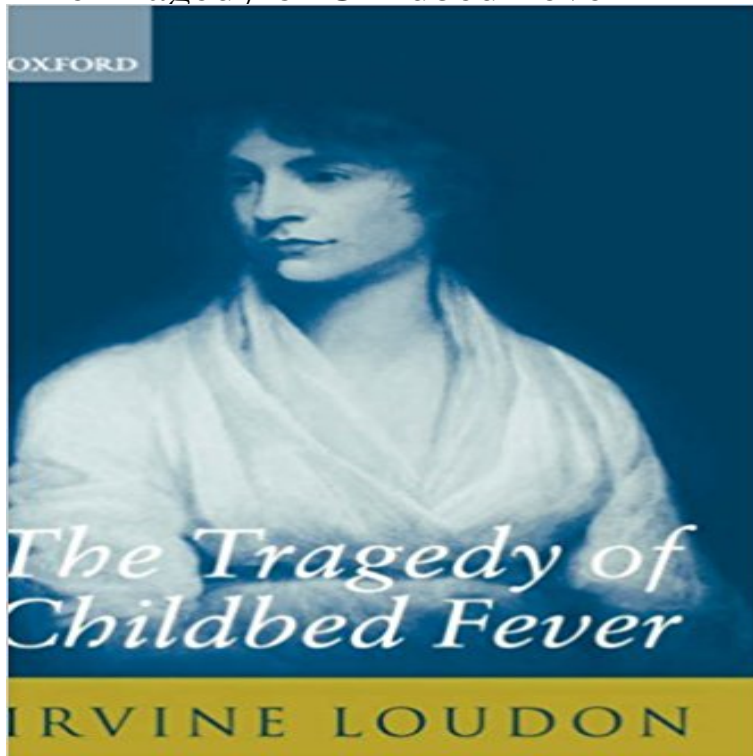


The Tragedy of Childbed Fever
