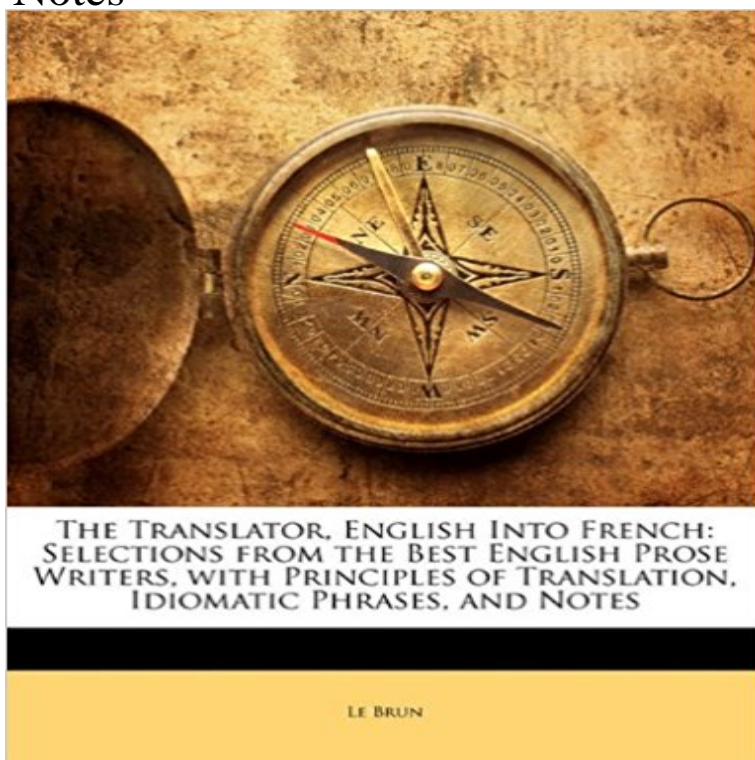


The Translator, English Into French: Selections from the Best English Prose Writers, with Principles of Translation, Idiomatic Phrases, and Notes
