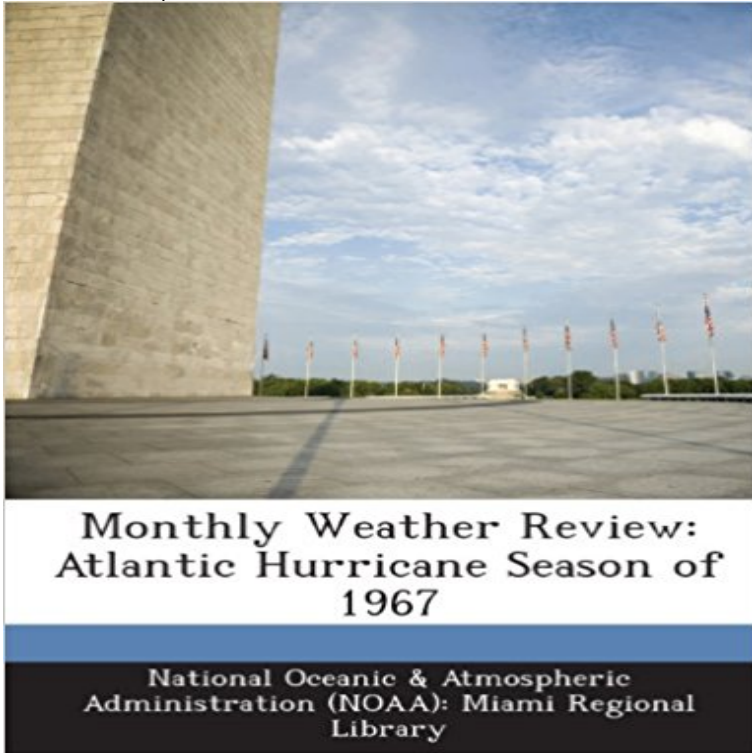


Monthly Weather Review: Atlantic Hurricane Season of 1967
